## OVERVIEW & OUTLINE ITINERARY

As Canada's largest city, Toronto has plenty to offer any traveller passing through. Renowned for its vast waterfront, multicultural districts, fascinating museums and one of the world's tallest buildings, the CN Tower, Toronto can be visited any time of the year as it has a milder climate than most of Canada, ensuring a pleasant stopover before or after your holiday in Central and South America.

- DAY 1** Arrive in Toronto, Canada and start exploring.
- DAY 2** Toronto Harbour and Islands Cruise
- DAY 3** Niagara Falls Day Tour
- DAY 4** Depart Toronto for your next destination.

## ITINERARY

On this 4-day stopover, you'll get to see Toronto's main sights, from 450 metres above ground in the CN Tower and on a short cruise along its scenic harbour – not to mention by foot as you'll be conveniently situated within the city. Before continuing on your journey, you'll also get a full day tour of the natural wonder that is Niagara Falls, passing through some of Canada's pristine natural beauty along the way.

### DAY 1

#### Arrive in Toronto, Canada and start exploring.

Arrive at Toronto Pearson International Airport where you will be met and taken by private transfer to your hotel.

You'll be within easy reach of the city's top attractions, so why not head out right away to explore? Head to Toronto's famous CN Tower – your tickets will already be booked – for a 450-metre ascent and panoramic views over the city. You'll get your bearings and get to see Canada's largest city in all its glory.

### DAY 2

#### Toronto Harbour and Islands Cruise

Today, you'll get to enjoy a short 1-hour cruise through the Toronto Harbour, taking in scenic skyline views and historic landmarks, as well as passing through the Toronto Islands, a chain of 15 small islands just south of the harbour.

Afterwards, explore the vast waterfront and downtown of multicultural Toronto – you'll find plenty to see and do, like visiting the Royal Ontario Museum with the world's largest fossil collection. End the day with some excellent dining, which can be found across the city's diverse neighbourhoods, such as Kensington Market, Portugal Village, Greek Town, Chinatown and Koreatown.

### DAY 3

#### Niagara Falls Day Tour

This morning, you will depart from downtown Toronto for a full-day tour of Niagara Falls. One of North America's most breath taking natural wonders, you'll get to witness the incredible sight of millions of gallons of water – around a fifth of the world's fresh water – plunging over sheer cliffs, as well as pass through some the area's beautiful surroundings, including the Niagara Parkway, which winds along the Niagara Gorge and the charming town of Niagara-on-the-Lake. You'll get historical commentary and fascinating facts from your knowledgeable guide throughout the experience.

#### Depart Toronto for your next destination.

Take a private transfer back to Toronto Pearson International Airport from your hotel.

### CLIMATE

Toronto has a milder climate than most of Canada, moderated by Lake Ontario. Summers (June-August) can get hot while winters are less severely cold. The best time to visit Toronto is June to September with temperatures ranging 20-27°C. It's coldest in winter (December to March), driest February to March, and comfortably mild in spring (April-May) and autumn (September-October).

### CLOTHING AND SPECIAL EQUIPMENT

Warm winter clothing is essential if visiting from October to March.
